James E. Moliterno is the Vincent Bradford Professor of Law at Washington and Lee University School of Law, US. For 21 years prior to joining the W&L faculty in 2009, he was the Tazewell Taylor Professor of Law, Director of the Legal Skills Program, and Director of Clinical Programs at the College of William & Mary, serving also as Vice Dean from 1997-2000. He has taught legal ethics courses and professional skills courses at six law schools over the past thirty years. A member of the American Law Institute, he has held committee leadership roles in both AALS and the ABA.
